— GRACE REFORMED BAPTIST CHURCH, PALMERSTON NORTH — We had an excellent School of Theology in July, at which Jim Renihan taught on the Doctrine of the Church with 12 men in attendance. While Jim will not be able to come next year we are continuing with plans to host our seventh School of Theology with a different speaker, trusting in God to provide in every way.

In the coming weeks we will be leafleting 1500 homes around the school where we meet, as we do three times each year. More often than not this has generated some measurable response with a visitor or two to a meeting, and we pray that the gospel message will be seed sown in hearts where it may germinate and be fruitful: only eternity will show the real value of such endeavours. With the departure of some of our members earlier in the year, confirmation that another family will move to Australia for work within the next two months, and the knowledge that a newly-married couple will head overseas to study in the New Year we face an uncertain future trusting that God will accomplish his purposes for his own glory.
